

DID YOU KNOW:

- ➔About 20 percent of Americans (40 million) report some degree of hearing loss (this number is probably higher as many do **not** report a hearing problem)
- ➔Hearing loss is a major public health issue that is the third most common physical condition after arthritis and heart disease
- ➔About 2-3 of every 1,000 children have a hearing impairment
- ➔At age 65, one of three people has a hearing loss
