

Learning a new letter...

This week in *Fundations*, we focused on the letters M and N. Sometimes distinguishing those two sounds is tricky but we did a lot of practicing and the students' hard work is paying off. We made mitten class books and monkeys and today did an M and N sort. We also learned how to form lower case m and n. The students did a great job!

## Having Fun with Math!

We spent time on number recognition this week and patterns of numbers. We built number rows from 0-10 and several students identified the growing pattern of adding one number to each row. It was clear that many friends are beginning to recognize several numbers from 0-10. We also worked with the concept of one more and one less. Students used dinosaur counters to figure out how many were swimming in a lake, and what would happen every time we added one more. Yesterday the students worked with partners to play "pocket math." They placed counters in envelope pockets and would ask their partners to use other counters to show how many were in the pocket. They would add or remove 1 or 2 counters at a time to practice one more and one less.


### Love the changing colors of leaves!
