Having Fun with Math!

We spent time this week working on number recognition and number sense for 1-10. We learned that there are many ways to show a number. For example, whether we use 4 popsicle sticks, 4 fingers, the number 4, or a drawing of 4 apples, they all show 4. We also formed a human number line with the numbers 1-10. I was able to hand each student a number and they worked together to put themselves in the right order.

Two New Letters plus Gingerbread Stories all week...

Our letters of the week were "P" and "J." We will be working with these letters next week as well since we are also doing lots of gingerbread activities. The students made penguins and did a P&B sort. They did an excellent job working independently overall to hear the different sounds P and B make. After reading several gingerbread stories, we spent time comparing and contrasting important elements of the stories, including characters and the endings of each. One fun activity was making life-sized gingerbread people. The students worked in teams of 3 to create a giant Gingerbread Friend. We were really impressed with how well the teams cooperated and worked together. I will send along pictures of the final projects this week.
