## Learning a new letter...

Since students have done such a great job blending and segmenting CVC words, this week we moved on to working with consonant digraphs. We discussed what happens when two letters come together to make one sound, such as "th," "sh," "ch," "wh," and "ck." The students did t/th and sh/s beginning sound sorts and started to practice tapping out four letter words that still make only three sounds.

## Having Fun with Math!

This week we played "Dice Addition" to practice saying joining stories out loud and adding up numbers to 5 . Students are working hard to learn their number facts to five from memory but they are also excellent at using manipulatives such as snap cubes, number lines and even their own fingers to help them solve number stories.

We also had a discussion this week on collections and the fun things one can do with a collection such as count and sort the items. We have decided to start a class collection of
Bottle Caps - please send in as many as you can collect over the next month. We are hoping to beat last year's total of over 500 bottle caps!

## We welcomed new living things...

This was an exciting week for our class in Science. We built a terrarium and planted tree seedlings and moss in the soil inside. We then added darkling beetles and pill bugs to the terrarium as well. We have spent the last few days studying the behaviors of these creatures. The students created detailed sketches of their observations. It was funny to learn that the beetles like to eat potatoes!
