Having Fun with Math...

This week we used five frames to count from 1-5 and played a game called "Quick Looks," during which students got quick looks at cards with dots on them and tried to see the groupings of dots to figure out how many were on each card. For instance, a student might say he/she saw four dots because there were two on top and two on the bottom, and two groups of two equal four.
